Central: Friday – Saturday, 17th – 18th November, 2016. Entries Due: Friday, 13th October, 2017

2017 Workshops

The key to a successful meet is advanced planning and utilizing the right resources. The FPSAA president, Mr. Cavu emphasized in his annual report during the AGM last year, the need to always strive for excellence.

In its effort to take the Chow Games to the next level, It was unanimously decided that we will need to enhance the skills of our officials by organizing workshops for the following areas:

Training officials in the use of the following two (2) softwares: Meet Manager and Team Manger. It was noted that the schools and districts that were able to use the software in 2016 discovered that besides cutting out on a lot of time and effort in the preparation of the overall program, it was also a great benefit as it allowed them to be accurate; removing the constant issue in regards to cheating.

Officiating: Knowing the rules of the meet with its events and being able to administer them correctly. We are still having athletes unfairly judged by officials who are not fully conversant with the rules. This session will be planned in conjunction with Athletics Fiji.

Coaching: Again, this session will be planned in conjunction with Athletics Fiji. It is very encouraging to note the increasing interest in this area of coaching from all Divisions.

Dates are to be advised.

Insurance

A similar coverage to 2016 is anticipated for this year's Divisional Championships. Districts must ensure that all their athletes and officials are covered. The team will be covered from when they leave their base up until they return to their base. To have the athletes covered we must have their proper names submitted with the entries. The names must be the names that appear on their birth certificates. This applies to both athletes and officials.

Support from the Ministry of Education

We need to have your District and Divisional Championship dates finalized so that we can make a single request for all of Divisions to the MOE. This we will be submitting by mid-February at the latest. Once your dates are finalized, please do not change them as this causes so much inconvenience; not only for the MOE, but also for the participating schools, parents and children. We must make every effort to be consistent.
